

PROPOSED TAX LEVY (ADDITIONAL)

HANOVER TOWNSHIP FIRE DISTRICT

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

An additional tax for the benefit of the Hanover Township Fire District for the purpose of providing and maintaining fire apparatus, mechanical resuscitators, underwater rescue and recovery equipment, or other fire equipment and appliances, buildings and sites therefor, or sources of water supply and materials therefor, for the establishment and maintenance of lines of fire-alarm communications, for the payment of firefighting companies or permanent, part-time, or volunteer firefighting, emergency medical service, administrative, or communications personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under section 145.48 or 742.34 of the Revised Code, for the purchase of ambulance equipment, for the provision of ambulance, paramedic, or other emergency medical services operated by a fire department or firefighting company, or for the payment of other related costs, that the county auditor estimates will collect \$1,136,292 annually, at a rate not exceeding three and five-tenths (3.5) mills for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$123 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for a period of five (5) years, commencing in 2025, first due in calendar year 2026.

AGAINST THE TAX LEVY

Current levy to expire is 3.5 Mills based upon 2016 property valuation figures. This new levy of the same mills 3.5 is based upon current valuation totals.

Estimated revenue is \$1,136,292.00 per tax year. Property valuation is \$324,454,730.00

Tax years: Commences in 2025 for five years.
